


WHITE HOUSE



Step into history at the **White House**, the official residence and workplace of every **U.S. president since 1800**. Located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue NW in Washington, D.C., this iconic Neoclassical masterpiece was designed by Irish-born architect James **Hoban**, inspired by Dublin's Leinster House. Discover its rich history, from its exterior of Aquia Creek sandstone to the low colonnades added by **Thomas Jefferson**.



AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY



Explore the wonders of the American Museum of Natural History (AMNH), a captivating institution nestled on the Upper West Side of Manhattan in the heart of New York City. Situated in Theodore Roosevelt Park, just steps away from Central Park, this expansive museum boasts 20 interconnected buildings, encompassing 45 permanent exhibition halls, a planetarium, and a library. AMNH's remarkable collections, totaling around 35 million specimens, encompass the natural world's diversity, from plants, animals, and fossils to cultural artifacts and human remains.



MADAME TUSSAUD'S WAX MUSEUM



Step into the world of Madame Tussauds, a wax museum with a rich history dating back to 1835 when it was founded by the French wax sculptor Marie Tussaud. Once known as 'Madame Tussaud's', the apostrophe is now omitted. The museum's journey led it to its current location on Marylebone Road in London in 1883, and the new galleries that opened in 1884 were an instant hit. Madame Tussauds has been a beloved tourist attraction in London since the Victorian era, featuring wax replicas of famous historical figures, as well as iconic film and TV characters portrayed by renowned actors. Operated by the entertainment company Merlin Entertainments, this captivating museum has expanded its presence globally, with branches in cities across four continents, starting with the opening of the first overseas location in Amsterdam in 1970.
