







#### **CARDIFF**







Thorpe Park Resort, commonly known as Thorpe Park, is an amusement park located in the village of Thorpe between the towns of Chertsey and Staines-upon-Thames in Surrey, England, 20 miles (32 km) southwest of Central London. It is operated by Merlin Entertainments and includes rides, themed cabins, live events and Stealth, the United Kingdom's fastest rollercoaster. In 2019 Thorpe park was the UK's third most visited theme park (1.9 million visitors), behind Alton Towers and Legoland Windsor.[1] However, in 2020, due to the coronavirus pandemic, the park only had a 125-day operation season, along with limited capacity, leading to massively reduced visitor numbers.[citation needed] Despite this, Thorpe Park was the second most attended theme park in the UK in 2020, behind Alton Towers.[1] After demolition of the Thorpe Park Estate in the 1930s, the site became a gravel pit managed by Ready Mix Concrete (RMC). When the pits were expanded, RMC regenerated the site for leisure, opening Thorpe Park as an outdoor activity park in 1979. It has since grown into one of the major theme parks in the UK. Major attractions include Tidal Wave, a large water ride, a number of roller coasters including Colossus, Nemesis Inferno, Stealth, Saw – The Ride, The Swarm, The Walking Dead: The Ride, and Ghost Train, a dark ride.



## LONDON-WINDSOR-BATH-CARDIFF



We leave **London** after breakfast. First, we will tour **Windsor Castle**, the world's longest-running palace, where **Elizabeth II** lived, and which is also the largest castle in the world. Then we will set out for Bath, one of Britain's most elite cities.

Bath is a city on the **UNESCO** world heritage list, famous for its Roman bath small souvenirs. It has wonderful architecture. After seeing small cafes, English bakeries, pubs on the banks of the **Avon River**...

Departure to **Cardiff**, capital of Wales. Arrival in **Cardiff** after an enjoyable bus ride of approximately one hour. Before transferring to our hotel, we will do a panoramic tour introducing the city of **Cardiff**. In this tour, we will see the **National Museum** of **Wales**, **Cardiff** 

Castle, Millennium Stadium, City Hall, Norwegian Church, Wales Millennium Center.



## **CARDIFF-CAERNARFON-CONWY CASTLE-LIVERPOOL**



Departing from our hotel after breakfast and passing through the oldest towns of **North Wales** on the west coast of **Britain**, **Caernarfon**, famous for its medieval castle modeled after the city walls of Istanbul, is also the place where the coronations of the Welsh princes are traditionally held. Then, there will be a photo stop at **Conwy Castle**, built by **King Edward I**, who conquered Wales in the 13th century. Stay in **Liverpool** 



### **LIVERPOOL-MANCHESTER-LONDON HOTEL**



We will make our panoramic city tour introducing **Liverpool**, one of the most important port cities of **Britain**. This is England's important industrial and commercial city. At the same time, the **"The Beatles"** community, which emerged from here in the 1960s, introduced **Liverpool** to the world, and with the city's unique architectural examples and rich exhibitions and museums, it moved it to the **UNESCO World Heritage** List in 2004 and to the **European** capital of culture in 2008. **Liverpool** is world-renowned for the success of the sports club named after the city in football. On our tour, after seeing the **Metropolitan** and **Anglican** cathedrals, we will see the historical buildings in **Albert Dock** that are under the protection of the state in the first degree.
